Young Masters Program: Audiovisual Materials Description Form - DANCE

Dance applicants should include one 4-minute video demonstrating their artistic achievement. Video can be sent on DVD or uploaded to Dropbox: <https://www.dropbox.com/>.

Submit samples in one format only. We can only accept the following file types: .wmv (preferred), .mov, .mp4, .flv.

Only 4 minutes will be viewed by the panel.

Dance audiovisual must contain:

- Solo performance (up to 4 minutes total).

Tips:

- Technique can be filmed in dance class with a tripod and video camera. Only the applicant should be in the video segment.
- Live performances will be accepted, but it must not be a group shot. The applicant must be easily identified. It should not be filmed from the back of the auditorium in an amateur manner.
- Dancers should not wear black costumes with black stage backdrops.
- DVD should be clearly marked. Test DVD before sending to ensure that it will play on a variety of computers.
- All samples should include audio (evaluators should be able to hear the music being danced to).

Ineligible:

- Drill team, cheerleading, competition dance, or baton twirling.
