

Grants up to \$5,000 for non-profit presenters

Up to 50% for state roster artists or ensembles  
OR  
up to 25% for non-roster artists or ensembles

An additional 10% for rural communities


FY15 so far: Grants in Texas totaling \$17,656

Topics include long-range planning, marketing, finance, law, and technology.


