Support of MasterPEACE: Young Artists Making a Kinder World, which uses art to teach non-violence in Dallas schools. Volunteers and paid artists facilitate the 14-lesson program, focusing on heroes of human rights and their unique approach to promoting peaceful behavior. Since 2007, MasterPEACE has served 3000 children in sixteen schools from grades 2-12. This activity is funded by Texas Women for the Arts.
