Arts Create \$4,240

To advance the creative economy of Texas by investing in the operations of this arts organization.

Arts Respond Economic Development \$1,250

To support the first San Antonio Movement Festival, a two-month event designed to create an atmosphere where participants will be inspired to make movement a part of their regular routine.

Arts Respond Education \$750

To support a series of arts-related classes, workshops, and performances for people of all ages.

Arts Respond Health & Human Services \$1,500

To support expansion of the Carver School for the Visual and Performing Arts weekly senior program into underserved senior centers in San Antonio.

Arts Respond Performance Support \$2,700

Artistic fee subsidy for Dallas Black Dance Theatre to perform in San Antonio on July 16-27, 2012. Dallas Black Dance Theatre's residency will be part of San Antonio's Movement Festival. It will include a dance intensive for San Antonio area students and a mainstage performance.
