### Binational Independent Film Festival

**Arts Respond Economic Development** **\$2,333**

*To support the 2014 Binational International Film Festival, which will showcase filmmakers from the US and Mexico as well as attract visitors to El Paso and offer local underserved youth opportunities to learn about the film business. (Award Reduction: TCA will not fund grants that exceed 25% of an organization's previous year's cash operating revenues)*

**Arts Respond Education** **\$2,042**

*To support the costs of presenting films to at-risk youth in El Paso schools as part of their curriculum, then bringing the students to meet with the filmmakers to discuss the work. (Award Reduction: TCA will not fund grants that exceed 25% of an organization's previous year's cash operating revenues)*

### El Paso Pro-Musica

**Arts Create** **\$6,000**

*To advance the creative economy of Texas by investing in the operations of this arts organization.*

**Arts Respond Health & Human Services** **\$1,500**

*To support the costs of chamber music performances and programs for underserved populations in senior centers, hospitals, and rehabilitation facilities in the El Paso area.*

### Theatre, Inc.

**Arts Respond Education** **\$3,000**

*To support providing school educational workshops and residencies focusing on creative drama and theatre design for students in the El Paso area.*

**Arts Respond Health & Human Services** **\$3,500**

*To support residencies for seniors in retirement homes and senior centers and for low-income seniors living in multigenerational households, which will focus on storytelling and developing family history books and voice recordings.*

**Arts Respond Public Safety & Criminal Justice** **\$2,500**

*To support theatre and creative writing workshops for El Paso area youth on juvenile probation.*
