Beeville Concert Association

Arts Respond Education **\$2,042**

To support 4 interactive drum concerts for 5th through 8th grade students in Beeville. (Award Reduction: TCA will not fund grants that exceed 25% of an organization's previous year's cash operating revenues)

Arts Respond Performance Support **\$6,750**

Artistic fee subsidy for the Symphony Society of San Antonio to perform in Beeville on January 25-28, 2014. The San Antonio Symphony will present two daytime young people's concerts for students from elementary through high school grades on January 25 and an evening concert for the community on January 28, 2014.

City of Seguin Main Street

Arts Respond Performance Support **\$850**

Artistic fee subsidy for the Urban 15 Group to perform in Seguin on October 26, 2013. The Urban 15 Street Dance & Drum Group will provide a public performance during Pecan Fest Heritage Day as part of the annual tribute to Texas hero Juan Seguin.

Arts Respond Performance Support **\$900**

Artistic fee subsidy for Bill Oliver to perform three musical sets during Seguin's Earth Day celebration on April 26, 2014. Mr. Oliver will work with area schools prior to the event, providing lyrics to his songs so students can perform with him.

Arts Respond Performance Support **\$1,166**

Artistic fee subsidy for R.J. Vandygriff to perform in George West on January 18, 2014. The performance marks the start of the celebration of the City of George West's 100th birthday.

To advance the creative economy of Texas by investing in the operations of this arts organization.

Arts Respond Economic Development **\$3,000**

To support symphonic concerts in Canyon Lake, Wimberley, Blanco, and Lockhart to generate audiences for the main concert season in Seguin and New Braunfels.

Arts Respond Economic Development **\$1,500**

To support a recital of performances from Conjunto Juan Seguin, Ballet Folklorico De La Rosa, and mariachi musicians that will attract visitors and provide income for musicians, artisans, technicians, and businesses.

Arts Respond Education **\$2,000**

To support folkloric dance residencies in Seguin elementary schools.

Arts Respond Health & Human Services **\$1,500**

To support providing a summer arts camp to children living in poverty in Seguin that will include physical activity through dance and instruction on nutrition and other health topics.

To support providing afterschool cultural arts instruction to students who are economically disadvantaged, at-risk, and have a history of juvenile delinquency, in Seguin.
