Arts Council of Brazos Valley

Arts Create - Year 2 **\$13,000**

To advance the creative economy of Texas by investing in the operations of this arts organization.



Arts Create- Subgranting - Year 2 **\$8,000**

Arts Respond Economic Development **\$2,600**

To support producing the Artist Showcase portion of the annual Texas Reds Festival in Historic Downtown Bryan.

Arts Respond Performance Support **\$775**

Artistic fee subsidy for Two Tons of Steel to perform in Bryan on October 17, 2014, in conjunction with the 2014 Red Wasp Film Festival. The feature film this year is music-related and the concert continues the music theme. The Arts Council is taking over management of the festival; the concert increases appeal and impacts a broader audience than previous years.
