Arts Create **\$6,500**

To advance the creative economy of Texas by investing in the operations of this arts organization.

Arts Respond Economic Development **\$3,000**

To support the artistic, production, and marketing costs associated with the Arts for All Family Festival that benefits local artists and provides an opportunity for residents and visitors to experience theater, music and visual arts.

Arts Respond Education **\$2,000**

To support educational theater workshops, tours, and demonstrations for 3rd-5th grade students in the Katy area.
